Why should I consider All Laser LASIK?

Choosing All Laser LASIK vision correction at Harman Eye Center will not just improve your vision; it will improve your quality of life. You are in good hands – David M. Harman, M.D. is a very experienced eye surgeon and has performed over 6,750 refractive surgeries and 5,300 LASIK procedures since 1999. We also are here to answer any questions throughout the process to eliminate any fears or inhibitions.

What is All Laser LASIK surgery?

LASIK is a surgical treatment for nearsightedness, farsightedness and/or astigmatism which reshapes the cornea.

With the All Laser LASIK method, the doctor creates a flap of corneal tissue with tiny, ultra-precise pulses of a VICTUS Femtosecond laser beam instead of a blade. The flap is then folded back and an Excimer laser is used to remove microscopic layers of tissue from the underlying cornea. Once the laser treatment is completed, the flap returns to its original position. We are proud that Harman Eye Center is the only practice in the region to offer advanced VICTUS Femtosecond laser technology. This entire procedure is blade-free!

How do I prepare?

We offer patients the option for a free personalized consultation to determine eligibility for LASIK surgery. The next step is a pre-operative dilated eye exam including testing to make sure your eyes are healthy and to confirm that you are a candidate for LASIK. If you are a contact lens wearer, you will need to keep your contacts out prior to that exam so that we can accurately measure your cornea. (At least 2 weeks for soft contacts and 4 weeks for hard contacts.) All of your testing and exam results will be reviewed with you at that appointment. If you are a candidate and wish to proceed, you may reserve your surgery date with a \$150.00 nonrefundable fee. This fee will be deducted from your balance due the day of your procedure.

Should I expect any pain?

Your eye will be numbed with a topical anesthetic prior to surgery for maximum comfort. Patients generally experience little or no discomfort during the procedure; and All Laser LASIK takes only minutes per eye. Following the procedure, it's possible that you will experience some mild irritation, such as the feeling of an eyelash in your eye – nothing to lose sleep over.

Day of surgery

You will check in at the Harman Eye Center at 1825 Graves Mill Road in Forest on the day of your surgery. The procedure itself will take about 10 minutes per eye; however, you will be at the office for about 2 hours so that we can prepare your eye for the surgery.

Let's talk pricing.

The cost for All Laser LASIK is \$2,100.00 per eye. Please ask for a special discount if you are a PCHP member, police officer, fire fighter, EMS or in the military. Within the cost, we include your post-operative kit, post-operative visits for one year and any retreatment within one year. Retreatments after one year are \$1,000.00 per eye.
